UOW Early Admission 2019 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Important dates for UOW Early Admission (for entry to UOW in 2020)

1 August 2019 - Applications open

30 August 2019 - 5pm - Applications close

3 August 2019 - Come to UOW Open Day to learn more about studying at UOW via Early Admission. Early Admission information sessions will be on at 10am, 12pm and 2pm. The Early Admission Application Hub will be open from 10am to 3pm, so you can start your application with help from the UOW Early Admission team.

16 September 2019 - Invitations to attend engagement activity (or activities) sent

30 September-3 October 2019 - In-person engagement activities

14-16 October 2019 - Official UOW offers sent to successful applicants.

WHAT IS UOW EARLY ADMISSION? Early Admission is a program that enables Year 12 students to receive an early offer to study at the University of Wollongong (UOW) based on a number of factors, including Year 11 subject performance, alignment to UOW indicators of success, and participation in a compulsory engagement (e.g. interview).

IMPORTANT DATES Applications open: 1 August 2019 Applications close: 30 August 2019 Invitations to EA Days: September 2019 Early Admission Days: 30 September- 3 October 2019 (school holidays) Offer release: 14-16 October (before HSC exams) UOW orientation: 25-27 February 2020 UOW lectures commence: 2 March 2020

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY? Students completing their final year at an Australian high school are eligible to apply. This includes: • Domestic students studying the NSW HSC (or interstate equivalent) or International Baccalaureate in Australia or at an Australian high school overseas (including pathway students studying Year 11/12 subjects in an alternative configuration); • International students studying the NSW HSC (or interstate equivalent) or International Baccalaureate in Australia.

HOW DO STUDENTS APPLY? Students apply online, directly to UOW. UOW has partnered with the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC) to provide a user-friendly application portal, where personal details are pre-populated based on student number and Year 11 results are automatically made available to UOW for assessment. This prevents the need for students, schools, and UOW to manually verify high school results.

HOW MANY PREFERENCES CAN STUDENTS SELECT? Each applicant can select up to two (2) preferences.

WHAT DOES UOW ASSESS FOR EARLY ADMISSION? UOW takes a holistic view of each individual, taking into account a range of factors that include: • Year 11 subject performance; • Application responses to UOW's identified indicator of success themes: academic readiness, motivation & passion,

planning & persistence, communication & collaboration; • Whether a student has experienced disadvantage that impacted their performance in Year 11, aligned in principle to UAC's Educational Access Scheme (EAS); • Whether students go to school in UOW's catchment area or in regional NSW; • Performance at required interview or participation in compulsory activity/s.

DO STUDENTS NEED TO APPLY THROUGH UAC AS WELL FOR EARLY ADMISSION?

Applying again through UAC for EA is not necessary. In previous years, students that received a successful outcome from UOW would need to apply through UAC and place their successful course as their highest eligible preference in order to receive an official offer. In 2019, students will receive an official offer in October, before sitting their HSC exams.

QUESTIONS WHAT SUBJECTS ARE MOST IMPORTANT FOR SPECIFIC DEGREES? UOW does not have pre-requisites for entry and as such, there are no specific subject criteria for Early Admission. UOW takes a holistic view of applicants, assessing on the merits of their application and performance at interview or participation in engagement activities. UOW provides recommended study for courses on entry to Year 11 (Future Finder publication) and good results in relevant subjects (e.g. Mathematics for Engineering degrees) is likely to be advantageous when reviewing Year 11 performance.

DO STUDENTS HAVE TO ATTEND AN INTERVIEW? Students must attend an interview or other compulsory on-campus engagement that will take place in the September school holidays (30 Sept – 3 October 2019) in order to be eligible for a UOW offer.

HOW DO STUDENTS KNOW WHICH ACTIVITY THEY ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND? UOW will contact students in September with an invitation to attend a compulsory on-campus activity that is best suited to them (determined by UOW's assessment of their online application). Applicants will be instructed to log back into the system to book a 2 hour timeslot on one of the Early Admission Days. For students that require an interview, they will additionally book a 15 minute interview allotment within their 2 hour timeslot. Further details of the various activities at these days will be available in late July.

WHAT IF A STUDENT LIVES A LONG WAY FROM WOLLONGONG? Students can request a phone interview instead of the on-campus engagement if they are more than a 4-hour drive from Wollongong. However, attendance is strongly encouraged.

WHAT IF A STUDENT CANNOT / DOES NOT ATTEND A COMPULSORY ENGAGEMENT? Depending on the circumstances, students who cannot attend their compulsory on-campus engagement will instead receive a phone interview. For students who do not attend a compulsory engagement and additionally have not been contactable by phone, UOW will consider a UOW College offer (where appropriate) or will deem the student ineligible.

WHEN WILL SUCCESSFUL STUDENTS RECEIVE AN OFFER? Students will receive an official offer in October, before sitting their HSC exams.

WHAT IF A STUDENT IS NOT SUCCESSFUL AT INTERVIEW? Students will be considered for any other preference they have, and will either receive an alternative UOW or UOW College offer, depending on the individual student's demonstrated capability.

CAN STUDENTS RECEIVE AN OFFER FOR BOTH PREFERENCES? Yes, students may receive multiple offers, depending on number of preferences and associated outcomes. A double degree (e.g. Bachelor of Commerce – Bachelor of Laws) counts as one preference.

WILL THERE BE CONDITIONS ON OFFERS? All students must complete Year 12 (HSC, interstate equivalent, or International Baccalaureate). Some students will additionally need to meet one or more Year 12 subject requirements (either satisfactory completion or specified band, detailed on official offer).

In other news, the Early Offer Year 12 (E12) Scheme is now open!

The E12 Scheme is available to students who have experienced financial disadvantage during their time at school and demonstrate the potential to succeed at the University of Sydney. Successful applicants receive conditional early entry with lower minimum ATAR requirements, in addition to a \$5950 scholarship to support their transition to university study. This year, over 90 courses are offered via E12, meaning applicants can select from more courses than ever.

To be eligible for E12, students will need to be assessed by UAC via the [Educational Access Scheme \(EAS\)](#):

- as [experiencing financial hardship](#) or
- residing at the time of your UAC application in an area identified by the Australian Bureau of Statistics Socio-Economic Indexes for Areas ([SEIFA](#)) as being in the [lowest 30% of socio-economic disadvantage](#) in Australia.

Successful E12 applicants who receive an early conditional offer to a B Commerce or B Commerce/B Advanced Studies are invited to apply for our [Inspired By Business Scholarship](#). This is one of our most generous faculty-based scholarships:

- B Commerce: \$10,000 per year for 3 years
- B Commerce/B Advanced Studies: \$10,000 per year for 4 years

This scholarship is only available to students who have applied for the [E12 Scheme](#) and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students through the [Cadigal Program](#).

Once you've applied, you can change the order of your preferences – or even the courses you've selected – as often as you like before the closing dates for each offer round. (Some courses have early application closing dates so check for these as well.) Simply log in to your application or the My UAC mobile app using your UAC application number and UAC PIN. You can't change your preferences by phone, letter or email.

The Susan and Isaac Wakil Foundation scholarship seeks to support motivated individuals with demonstrated merit who are facing hardship to realise their career goals and contribute to a better and brighter Australia. <https://publiceducationfoundation.org.au/susan-and-isaac-wakil-foundation-scholarships/>

The scholarship provides financial assistance to high potential students in **Year 12 who intend to continue studying either at TAFE or University after finishing their Higher School Certificate**.
