# **Early Admission**

## WSU Early Entry - True Rewards:

- 1 August: Applications open.
- · Closing dates TBC.
- Register online for updates.
- Direct applications to WSU are free of charge. 6 preferences, one offer.
- No ATAR required. Offers based on HSC subject band results (and Year 11 - TBC).
- Offers released prior to ATAR release.
- UAC application required for True Reward exclusion courses i.e.
   Architecture, OT, Para-medicine, Law etc.

Please be aware that all dates are subject to change. We will continue to update you throughout the year.

## **Notre Dame Early Entry:**

- 21 April: Applications open.
- 1 September: Applications close
- 28 August: Open Day.
- Offers released prior to HSC exams.
- Based on Year 11 and 12 results, and non-academic criteria.
- GET IN EARLY as offers are made within 4 weeks of submission.
- Now CSP for ALL courses. Fees now on par with other universities.
- Tertiary Pathway Program included in early offer. One semester, fee free. 14 weeks around 10 hours / week + study. Students will be offered a place in a semester 2 Bachelor degree course, upon successful completion.

# **UNE Early Entry:**

- Open now for direct entry.
- 17 September: Applications close.
- November: Offers released (TBC)
- Up to three course preferences.
- Offers are based on school ratings (no academic evidence required).
- Pathways enabling course (fee exempt for 2 trimesters) available to students who don't meet entry requirements.
   Completion of the course equates to ATAR of 77.10 (excludes some course).
- Pathway course will lead into B. degree upon successful completion. Credit given as RPL.
- Flexible delivery online courses, with intensive schools throughout year (2 days-2 weeks in Armidale).

- Motivation and passion: What has influenced your decision to purse your course of interest?
- Communication and collaboration: Describe a time when you worked with others to achieve a goal.
- Planning and persistence: Tell us about a time when you set yourself a goal and worked really hard to achieve a good result. (500 characters).

# **HSC & NESA Updates**

## **UAC Key Dates:**

- 1 April: Applications open.
- 30 September: UAC application early-bird rate increases from \$70, to \$200.
- 10 December: ATARs released from 9.00am (HSC results released from 6.00am).
- 13 December: Closing date for change of preferences for December Round 2 offers.
- 20 December: First mainstream round offer.
- 6 January: Closing date for change of preferences for January Round 1 offers.
- 13 January: January Round 1 offers are released.
- 20 January: Closing date for change of preferences for January Round 2 offer.
- 27 January: Round 2 offers released.
- Only one offer can be received each round. Accept and manage preferences each offer round.

## **Educational Access Scheme (EAS):**

- Scheme for students who have experienced disadvantage due to circumstances beyond their control, for at least six months during Year 11 and / or Year 12.
- 1 April: Applications open.
- Documentation accessible via your UAC application (once application fee is paid).
- All documentation must be uploaded at least two weeks before the undergraduate offer round in which you wish to be considered.
- Educational Impact Statement (EIS) should be organised with teacher ASAP.

## **Elite Athletes / Performers Scheme:**

Universities offer adjustment factors for elite athletes. Eligibility criteria changes for each institution. Please see me for more information.

## **Schools Recommendation Scheme:**

- 1 April: Applications open.
- Institution specific criteria, including Year 11 results, school ratings, EAS etc. Check each university as some still require a minimum ATAR for some courses.
- 19 September: Applications close.
- TBC September: School ratings portal closes.
- 4 November: Lock-in preferences by midnight.
- 12 November: Round 1 offers released.
- 18 November: Lock-in preferences by midnight.
- 25 November: Round 1 offers released.
- 2 December: Lock-in preferences by midnight.
- 9 December: Round 1 offers released.

### **ATAR and Selection Ranks:**

- Adjustment factors (bonus points)
   offered for high performance in Year
   12 subjects, living in a local
   catchment area, elite athletes or EAS
- Adjustment factors do not change your ATAR; they change your selection rank.
- Selection rank = ATAR + Adjustment factors
- No need to apply for subject adjustment factors as they are automatically applied (documentation required for EAS, Elite Athletes Program etc.).
- Investigate what adjustment factors you may be eligible for and work hard in those subjects to increase your performance.

## **HSC Exam Timetable and Results:**

- 4 November: Exams conclude (Thurs).
- 10 December: HSC results released at 6am, via SMS and Students Online.
