We will continue to update you throughout the year.</i></p>	<p><b><u>Notre Dame Early Entry:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 21 April: Applications open.</li> <li>• 1 September: Applications close</li> <li>• 28 August: Open Day.</li> <li>• Offers released prior to HSC exams.</li> <li>• Based on Year 11 and 12 results, and non-academic criteria.</li> <li>• GET IN EARLY as offers are made within 4 weeks of submission.</li> <li>• Now CSP for ALL courses. Fees now on par with other universities.</li> <li>• Tertiary Pathway Program included in early offer. One semester, fee free. 14 weeks around 10 hours / week + study. Students will be offered a place in a semester 2 Bachelor degree course, upon successful completion.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>UNE Early Entry:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open now for direct entry.</li> <li>• 17 September: Applications close.</li> <li>• November: Offers released (TBC)</li> <li>• Up to three course preferences.</li> <li>• Offers are based on school ratings (no academic evidence required).</li> <li>• Pathways enabling course (fee exempt for 2 trimesters) available to students who don't meet entry requirements. Completion of the course equates to ATAR of 77.10 (excludes some course).</li> <li>• Pathway course will lead into B. degree upon successful completion. Credit given as RPL.</li> <li>• Flexible delivery - online courses, with intensive schools throughout year (2 days-2 weeks in Armidale).</li> </ul>

<p><b><u>UAC Key Dates:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 April: Applications open.</li> <li>• 30 September: UAC application early-bird rate increases from \$70, to \$200.</li> <li>• 10 December: ATARs released from 9.00am (HSC results released from 6.00am).</li> <li>• 13 December: Closing date for change of preferences for December Round 2 offers.</li> <li>• 20 December: First mainstream round offer.</li> <li>• 6 January: Closing date for change of preferences for January Round 1 offers.</li> <li>• 13 January: January Round 1 offers are released.</li> <li>• 20 January: Closing date for change of preferences for January Round 2 offer.</li> <li>• 27 January: Round 2 offers released.</li> <li>• Only one offer can be received each round. Check that all of your details are correct, and all subjects are included.</li> </ul>
