	I will not attach any school-owned equipment to my mobile device without the permission of the school.

	I will not hack or bypass any hardware and software security implemented by the department or my school.
	I will not use my own device to knowingly search for, link to, access or send anything that is:

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RPS BYOD Device Requirements

Wireless connectivity:

Primary schools: The department's Wi-Fi network installed in primary schools operates on the **802.11n 5Ghz standard**. Devices that do not support this standard will not be able to connect.

Operating system:

The current or prior version of any operating system.

Software and apps:

All software and apps should be fully updated.

At the beginning of each term students will be provided with a list of apps required for the following term program.

Parents should ensure student devices have the following apps downloaded

iMovie, (or android equivalent eg Video Show), Prezi, Book Creator.

All devices require the Google Suite of apps (Docs, Drive, Sheets, Slides)

Battery life:

A minimum of 5 hrs battery life to last the school day.

Memory and RAM:

A minimum specification of 16 GB storage and 2 GB RAM to process and store data effectively.

Hardware features:

Camera and microphone.

Ergonomics:

Reasonable tablet sized screen to enable continuous use throughout the day. A Bluetooth keyboard is optional.

Other considerations

Weight: Lightweight for ease of carrying/filming.

Durability: Durable and strong.

Accessories

Casing: Tough and sturdy to avoid breakage (highly recommended that a tough case be purchased and fitted).



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RPS BYOD Student Responsibilities

NSW Department of Education Wi-Fi network connection only:

Student devices are only permitted to connect to the internet via the department's secure Wi-Fi network while at school. There is no cost for this service. "Wi-Fi only" devices are encouraged, any 3G/4G capable devices should have the SIM card removed and stored at home. Students must not bypass the school network by using any 3G/4G SIM card.

Battery life and charging:

Students must ensure they bring their device to school fully charged for the entire school day. *No charging equipment will be supplied by the school.*

Theft and damage:

Students are responsible for securing and protecting their devices at school - lockable secure storage will be available in the classroom. Parents are encouraged to enable the "Find My iPad" app, or similar security / location based app. All measures will be taken to support students to safe guard and care for their devices appropriately.

Any loss or damage to a device is not the responsibility of the school or the DoE. Please investigate whether your existing "Home and Contents" insurance may extend coverage to this device as neither DoE nor the school can accept any liability or responsibility for loss or damage.

Confiscation:

Student devices may be confiscated if the school has reasonable grounds to suspect that a device contains data which breaches the BYOD Student Agreement.

Maintenance and support:

Students are solely responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their devices.

Ergonomics:

Students should ensure they are comfortable using their device during the school day particularly in relation to screen size. Smartphones are not ideal due to their small screen size. Laptops are not ideal due to their size and weight. iPad and Tablet devices are recommended as suitable for this initiative.

Data back-up:

Students are responsible for backing-up their own data and should ensure this is done regularly.

Insurance/warranty:

Students and their parents/caregivers are responsible for arranging their own insurance and should be aware of the warranty conditions for the device.
